Ever wanted to gain new skills, explore a new field, and potentially earn your teacher certification all at once?

Consider enrolling in a GWTeach course for the Fall of 2020 to earn two careers in four years! GWTeach classes expose students to innovative lesson models and teaching strategies. Students then use their

new skills to plan and implement STEM lessons in K-12 DC schools. If you fall in love with teaching and the GWTeach program, you have the option of continuing through the entire

course sequence to earn a minor in STEM Teaching. Many students choose to take their minor a step further and complete one additional class, Apprentice Teaching, to earn their teacher certification. Those who earn teacher


certification through GWTeach are able to teach in DC once they graduate. Don't want to teach in DC? 46 states have reciprocity agreements with DC, which allows you to transfer the teacher certification to another state. Even if you don't see yourself as a teacher, you can still gain a lot of new skills from GWTeach courses. Teaching can improve your public speaking skills, time management skills, leadership skills, and your ability to explain concepts with clarity.


